



HEAVY CHEMISTRY IN MIAMISBURG – **CSX TRAIN DERAILMENT CAUSES MASS EVACUATION** **IN MIAMISBURG – JULY 28, 1986**

On July 28, 1986, 15 cars of a forty-four-car CSX Train derailed in Miamisburg, Ohio. Some of the cars contained phosphorus forcing city officials to evacuate thousands of people from their homes, causing one of the largest evacuation to occur in Ohio's history.

He's currently serving as an Instructor for U.S. Department of Labor, OSHA 10 & 30 Hour Course Training Certifications. Mr. Ring owns and operates his own business, the Administrative & Technical Services LLC, an Industrial Safety, Consulting and Training Service.
