The effort to establish and develop a museum which preserved notable physical artifacts and written records of accomplishment at Mound Laboratory and its predecessor, Dayton Project, was initiated twenty years ago. Dr. Don Sullenger was involved with this endeavor from its initiation until family responsibilities in 2012 forced him to largely cease his participation in it. He will present an account of the varied activities he engaged in during that period and some of the results accruing from attempting to bring the public's attention to Mound's half century of notable scientific/technical achievement underpinning the nation's security and technical leadership.
