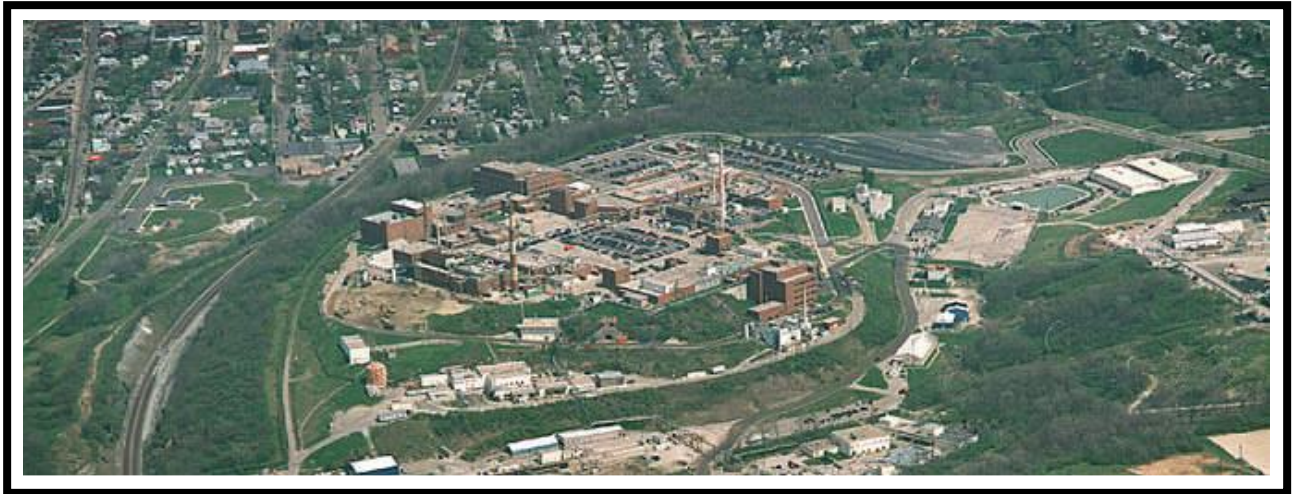

MIAMISBURG, OHIO”**

This presentation will provide a broad historical overview of the Mound Laboratory and its employees over the nearly 60 years that major contributions were made for national defense, space exploration, energy development, and other applications. The scope of activities will be summarized along with major events and changes that occurred throughout the eras of both operation and closure. The intent is to provide a more complete description of what actually took place “behind the fences” of this formerly highly-classified institution.

Dr. Robert Bowman holds B.S., M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Chemistry and was employed as a research staff member at the Mound Laboratory from 1969 until he left as a Science Fellow in 1984. Following his Mound Lab employment, he worked for three aerospace organizations in southern California. Bob is currently a Distinguished Staff Member at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory and he is also a board member of the Mound Science and Energy Museum Association.
